



SOIL & PERCOLATION TESTING

A soil percolation test is required to be carried out on land where a septic tank system or sewage treatment plant soakaway is intended to be built. It determines the rate in which soil absorbs a known volume of water. This is to make sure that the land (soil) is suitable, and to make sure that the soakaway is designed properly.
